Patient Support Programme Sponsorship

On 24 July 2025, Curie Foundation Ltd contributed S\$2,000 to support BTSS’s patient education programme titled *“MENOPAUSE: How It Affects Patients with Cancer and Brain Tumours”*, held at Enchanted Garden @ V Hotel.

The session was well attended by approximately 50 participants and provided meaningful insights into the physical and emotional challenges associated with menopause in cancer and brain tumour patients. Participants shared positive feedback, noting that the discussion was informative, supportive, and helpful in enhancing their understanding of symptom management and overall well-being during treatment and recovery.

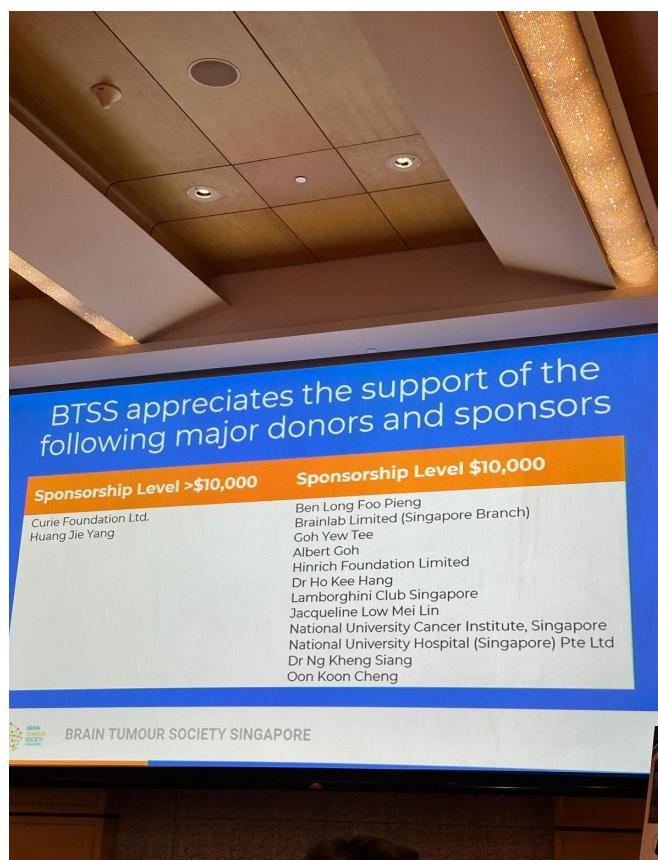
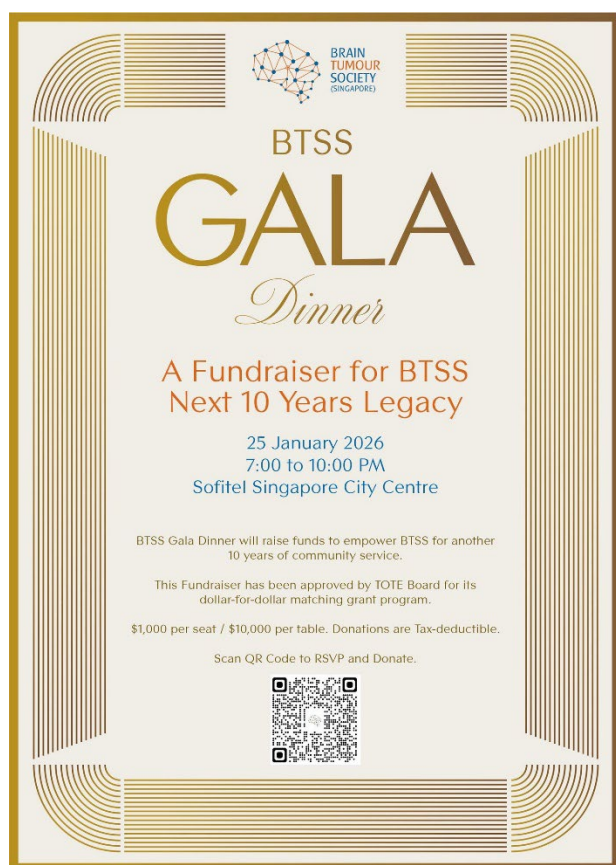


BTSS Charity Gala Dinner 2025
